Part of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, WIC stands for **Women, Infants, and Children** and aims to assist eligible low-income women, infants and children in meeting their nutrition and health needs by providing nutritious foods, nutrition education, and healthcare referrals.

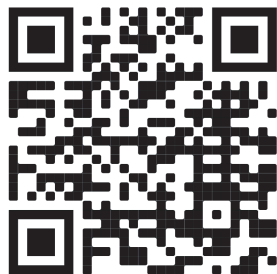

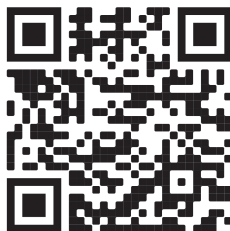
